Planned last Sunday at Christian College is **Sunday May 17th**.

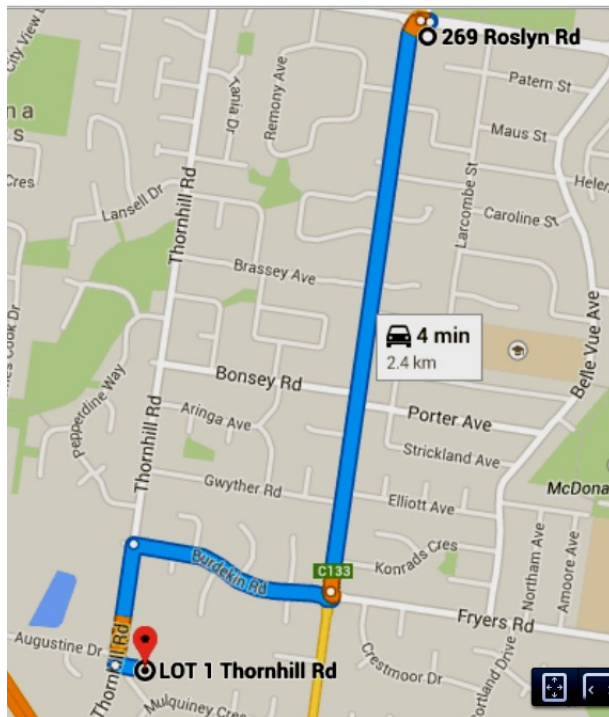
Planned first Sunday in new buildings, God-willing, is **Sunday May 24th**.

Directions

- Leaving the St. John's main carpark, turn left at the Roslyn Rd roundabout and drive down South Valley Rd.
- At the South Valley Rd / Burdekin Rd roundabout, turn right and drive to the end of the street. You will pass the main entrance of Christian College.
- At the end of Burdekin Rd, turn left onto Thornhill Rd.
- Drive along Thornhill to the far side of the Christian College campus (on the left) and turn left into the carpark there.
- Walk through into the central court. The Chapel can be accessed from this central court.
