Fees for mainly music (based on \$6 per family per week) are typically \$54 or \$60 per term depending on the number of school weeks. If you require any financial assistance please speak privately to a volunteer on the welcome table.

About the program

Each **Thursday** morning together **10:00am to 11:30am** includes music, morning tea and free play.

Each term we introduce a new set of songs often around a theme (Beach, Transport, Farm animals etc). We use instruments like shakers and we sing / say nursery rhymes and use our bodies to dance and move. As



we aim to facilitate involvement between parents/carers and children, so we encourage adults to sing and dance and move with their children.
